Painting for Child Abuse Prevention

Safe Children, Strong Families

In April 2008 and April 2009, Pennsylvania Family Support Alliance partnered with over a dozen state and local organizations to spread the word that child abuse can be prevented by strengthening families and supporting parents. Each year, our efforts resulted in the creation of four unique, collaborative murals, which serve as ongoing reminders of Child Abuse Prevention Month. Designed by the artists but painted by families, children, legislators and interested citizens. They are now hanging in Allentown, Harrisburg, Pittsburgh, Philadelphia and Scranton., and Uniontown.

“Painting for Prevention” will be repeated in April 2010 in several locations across the state, including Harrisburg, Greensburg (Westmoreland County) and Langhorne (Bucks County).

Financial support from sponsors for the event raises public awareness of the problem of child abuse. The money we raise each year goes to prevention initiatives and family support programs.
